02/9/2022	<p>Respondents filled WP 20176/2022 for seeking a direction to the Petitioners to grant regular pay scale to the Respondents of the post held by them or at least pay the minimum of the pay scale of the post held by Respondents from the date of their permanent classification i.e. from 03/01/1998.</p>
27/09/2022	<p>The Writ Petition was disposed of by an order dated 27/09/2022 and the Respondents were directed to submit a fresh representation to the Petitioner No 4 and the Petitioner No 4 was directed to decide the representation in the light of order passed in the case of</p>

	<p>Ram naresh Rawat (supra), within 4 months. it was further directed that in case the Respondents were found entitled for the benefit claimed by them, the benefit may be extended to them.</p>

Division Sidhi dated 30/12/2022 by which the benefit of minimum of the pay scale of the post held from the date of the permanent classification was denied to them and for direction to the Petitioners to give the benefits</p>
